Be E³ Smart FAQs



General Questions

Q: Will I receive my deposit back?

A: Yes. Your \$50 refundable deposit reserves your spot at the professional development workshop. Your check will not be cashed, and it will be returned to you at the end of the workshop. Your deposit is only forfeited if you do not attend the professional development workshop.

Q: How do you select participants?

A: Priority will be given to the following teachers:

- All participants must teach in schools served by DP&L and Vectren.
- All participants must teach 5-12 grade science.
- Preference will be given based on the number of teachers per school and/or district compared to the total number of applications received.

Q: What is the cost for the program?

A: There is no cost. All professional development, classroom materials and student kits are FREE!

Teachers Who Previously Participated

Q: Am I eligible to participate again?

A: You may participate in the program, but only if all required data and feedback for the previous year were submitted on time.

Q: Do I have to attend the full training again?

A: You are welcome to attend the all-day training or may choose the brief three-hour training at which time you will be briefed on all changes and given a refresher set of classroom materials along with any new supplies. Returning teachers will also have an opportunity to share their experiences with the program with teachers new to the program.

Q: Can I get the one hour graduate credit?

A: Yes, but you must attend one of the all-day training workshops.
