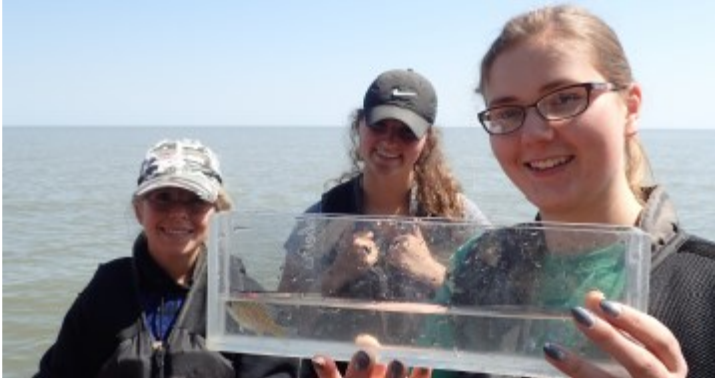


2022 will be a virtual year once again, and we hope you can join us.

# Ohio's Environmental Education Certification Program



Ohio's EE Certification program is sponsored by EECO. This certification program is based on North American Association of Environmental Education's national [competencies](#) for an Environmental Educator. The ability to earn two graduate credits through Kent State University, allows formal educators the opportunity to gain professional development in a way that is recognized by the Ohio Department of Education. It is a fee-based program that costs \$250. The fee includes all instruction, materials, EECO membership, and one-day registration for EECO's annual conference. If all the requirements have been met, certification will be awarded at the annual conference.

Training will occur in a mostly asynchronous style using the CANVAS online platform with some virtual meetings and discussions.

- Personal and Civic Responsibility
- Planning and Implementing Environmental Ed.
